Greetings to all Parents, Caregivers, and whanau,

Outdoor Learning Area:

This was finally completed over the school holiday and it looks amazing! Most of you would have seen photos on either the school facebook page or in this weeks River City Press. The children are really enjoying the new areas including the sandpit. They are making full use of the shaded areas to eat their morning tea and healthy lunches.

Healthy Lunches:

Aberfeldy School was lucky enough to take part in the trial of healthy lunches being provided by the Ministry of Education. Everyday receive individually packed healthy lunches for all of our students. You can check out the school facebook page to see what each days menu is. Children still need to bring



along morning tea and a water bottle each day. Some students may want additional lunch items to what is provided and they will let you know. It is great to part of this programme and to see our students all sitting down eating healthy lunches together. Our fruit in schools will also resume next week.

Swimming:

Our pool is looking amazing and the students are taking full advantage of the pool in this hot weather. ALL students need to bring togs and a towel every day (and a plastic bag to put wet gear into). Swimming is part of our school curriculum and each day there will be structured swimming lessons so participation is compulsory unless a note is received.

Sunhats & Sunblock:

Aberfeldy School is a Sun Smart school and we have provided all students with a sunhat that is to remain at school. Students may choose to bring their own hats from home. Sunblock is available at school, but if you have a preference to what sunblock your child uses then, please send some along to school. Students must wear sunhats when they are outside and need to apply sunblock regularly throughout the day.
