Term Dates and Events:

We have confirmed a visit to the Whanganui Regional Museum to have sessions on Whakapakoko (Taxidermy) and Pakiwaitara (Traditional Stories); and we will try to arrange a trip to the



Wanganui East swimming pool (or Splash) in the afternoon.

The whole school is booked in to attend the Science Roadshow on the 30th March and Duffy Theatre are tentatively booked to visit the school on Monday 10th April - although some activities will be Covid 19 dependent.



Technology Year 8 students:

Technology at Cullinane College for our Year 7 & 8 students will start on Thursday 17th February.

Student's will come to school as normal in the morning. Our students will be doing Drama / Dance and Music for the first 12 weeks (so closed in shoes are not required). It is an expectation of Cullinane College that students do not wear hoodies or hats in class. After the first week, depending on our school structure and time allowances, you may be asked to collect your child from Cullinane College in the afternoons; otherwise your child Year 7 & 8 child will be dropped home at the conclusion of technology - usually around 1.45 - 2.00pm.

Hearing & Vision Testing:

Standard hearing and vision testing of New Entrants and Year 7 students will be carried out at school on Tuesday 15th February.

If you have any concerns about your child's hearing or vision (if they are not a New Entrant or Year 7), and would like for these to be checked on the day please contact the school immediately so a consent / referral form can be sent home.

Year 7 & 8 Immunisation:

Year & & 8 students will be offered free vaccinations at school (Year 7 vaccinations and HPV vaccinations). Vivienne East, our school Public Heath Nurse, will be at school next Wednesday, 16th February, at 12 noon to give an education session to the Year 7 & 8 students on what the vaccines are for; parents and caregivers are welcome to attend. The children will then be sent home with consent forms that you will need to complete. - Tap the big orange choose button. This will load your school and bring you to the settings page.
- Subscribe to the groups that are relevant to you, then click the 'go back' button on your phone, which will bring you to the main screen of your schools app.
