Greetings to all Parents, Caregivers, and whanau,

COMMONWEALTH GAMES at Mangamahu School:

Our children will be joining in with Mangamahu School to have our own Commonwealth Games, on Friday 19th August. These games have been arranged with the assistance of Sport Whanganui and will be held at Mangamahu School.

There will be a rotation of games throughout the day concluding with a medal ceremony. This event is tied to the completion of an inquiry unit based around the Commonwealth Games. Underpinned by the core values of humanity, equality and destiny, this day is aimed at uniting the Mangamahu and Aberfeldy family through a festival of sport and physical activity. The Commonwealth Games, often referred to as the 'Friendly Games' is renowned for inspiring athletes to compete in the spirit of friendship and fair play.

The students will rotate through 6 fun and exciting sport based activities, with each rotation lasting about 10-12 mins.

Town students will be collected by the van at their normal time. Aberfeldy students - Miracle, Shaniwa-Mae & Peter-Ray will come to school as usual; Chevelle, Tayahna & Ariana to please be brought to school by 8.30am; Jenelle & Ihaia will be collected on the way past their house - approximately 8.45am.

Town students will be returned home at their normal times.

We travel to Mangamahu School via Te Rimu Road - and not through town. We will be taking both school vans, so will have room for a couple of parent helpers if anyone does want to join us for the day.

Children need to bring -

- Suitable clothing to do athletics in; shoes are a good option as there may be prickles and it could be cold on their feet earlier in the day
- Students need to bring a water bottle
- Warm jacket it could get cold
- Suitable snacks to eat through the day. It is unlikely that we will be able to take our school lunches with us, so children will need to bring their own lunch with them. We will take additional "left over" lunches from Thursday for those that need them.

Downloading the Skool Loop app - a step by step guide

Once you have downloaded the Skool Loop App, via either your Google Play or App store, please follow the below instructions to select your school -

- Open the Skool Loop App you will land on a welcome page.
- Click the 'Select your schools' this will bring you to a menu you can either search your school
 or follow the country/region prompts.
- Once you reach your school, select it with the tick on the righthand side.
- Tap the 'select schools' button in the top right corner.
- Tap the big orange choose button. This will load your school and bring you to the settings page.
- Subscribe to the groups that are relevant to you, then click the 'go back' button on your phone, which will bring you to the main screen of your schools app.
