End of Year - Start of 2023:

Our last day of school is Tuesday 13th December 2022 and we return to school in 2023 on Monday 30th January 2023.

Wednesday 7th December - Bason Reserve Botanical Gardens

We will be joining Mangamahu School at the Bason Reserve Botanical Gardens from 10.00am to 2.00pm, for a fun day and to maintain our friendships with Mangamahu School. The children will be doing some orienteering, playing games and having a picnic lunch.

Town children will be picked up slightly later than normal (starting at 8.45am); Aberfeldy Country students will meet at school and leave from school by 9.00am. We will meet at the top gates of the Botanical Gardens at 9.45am. Parents and whanau are welcome to join us for the day.

Please ensure you child brings snacks, lunch (we probably will NOT have our school lunches) and plenty of water / drinks. Children will also need a sunhat and sunblock, shoes or sandals, and a jersey or jacket in case the weather changes (there can sometimes be a bit of a breeze out there). We will NOT be swimming so children do not require togs or towels.

Children will be home approximately one hour earlier than normal.

Friday 9th December - Craft Day $\,/\,$ End of Year Prize Giving

9.00am to 10.30am: Children will be making candles on Friday morning and doing a few other art projects before morning tea. After morning tea children will be able to complete any art projects and then swim.

12.00 noon Shared lunch: Whanau are invited to join us for a shared lunch. The school will provide a sausage sizzle and we will have our school lunches available so if you are able to bring along a plate to share that would also be most welcome.

1.00pm: Prize giving and Items by the children

Our return time to Whanganui will be determined by whether we go swimming or not - so children will be back anywhere between 2.30 and 4.00pm - we will call you as we return to Whanganui.
