Greetings to all Parents, Caregivers, and whanau.

And just like that we are in to Term Four!!

Term Four is always full of events and it goes by very quickly.

We look forward to welcoming our new tenants in the school house in two weeks, which will bring our roll to 12.

With spaces limited on the van, if you have siblings, family friend's or other families that you know of that would be interested in attending Aberfeldy School next year, now would be a good time to start making enquires and looking at holding seats on the van.

SCHOOL AS A VOTING PLACE:

The Aberfeldy School building will be used as Voting Place for the 2023 General Elections for the local community.

THURSDAYS:

Out Terrific Town Thursdays have finished for this year and normal school days have resumed, with our Seniors going into town for technology at 11.00am and returning home at the earlier time of around 2.00pm. All other students —Thursday is just a normal school day.

TE REO MAORI / KAPA HAKA:

Matua Doug has started his Te Reo Maori programme with our tamariki and they all enjoyed the first day (Wednesday) where they learnt some basic greeting for various situations, how to address different people (matua, whaea etc) a simple waiata and the correct pronunciation of the maori vowels.

MAK SPORTS DAY -17th October:

Our school will be travel through to Mangamahu School on Tuesday 17th October to combine with Managamahu, Kakatahi and Aberfeldy school for our MAK Sports Day and SPOT Day. We will be leaving school at 9.00am and travelling over Te Rimu Road. Children will need suitable clothing for play and sports, shoes, morning tea, drinks, sun hat.

As you may be aware it is 'Get Spotted' next week to raise melanoma awareness, so our children are being asked to dress up in either spotty clothes or bright colours for the day. There will be a competition for the "Most Spottiest", "Most Colourful" and "Goofiest".

SWIMMING:

We have started swimming and children need to be bringing togs and towel everyday—along with a bag to put wet togs into if they are taking them home. After Labour weekend, swimming will be a compulsory part of the school curriculum and children will need to bring a note, or parent email the school, if their child is not taking part in swimming.

TECHNOLOGY:

Year 7 & 8 students attend technology at Cullinane College on a Thursday from 11.40am to 1.40pm. Currently the children are doing Digital. The children come to school as per usual in the morning, travel back to town for technology and then arrive home by 2.00pm.

We ask if town parents are able to collect children at the conclusion of technology to save having our van and teacher aide in town all day (parents will be contacted later regarding this).

A reminder that Monday 23rd October is Labour Day and there will be NO SCHOOL.


